Dull's Tree Farm in Thorntown, Indiana combined with Indiana and Illinois. Christmas Tree Associations

A year ago our lives changed dramatically with the word COVID-19. Summer meetings were postponed or held virtually. We in the Christmas tree industry missed the camaraderie of seeing other growers and learning from each other. We missed seeing our vendors. Shopping online is just *not* the same.

We are looking forward to seeing everyone we missed last year!

Dull's Tree Farm - Their story:

Tom and Kerry Dull moved into their historic 1800s Boone County farmstead a mile west of Ind. 39 when they were married in 1982. At the time, the big old post-and-beam house overlooked fields of corn and soybeans. That first Christmas, they drove 30 miles to pick out their Christmas tree. It was the beginning of a tradition they now share with their own family as well as thousands of families who make a visit to Dull's Tree Farm to celebrate Christ's birth.

Upon college graduation, Tom and Kerry moved back to the family farm to join Tom's parents raising livestock and growing grain crops. In 1985 they decided to try growing Christmas trees on the gentle slopes around the homestead and planted 200 trees. When they survived, they

planted more and spent the next few years tending them, sweating in the hot June sun to shear them to the perfect shape, and looking forward to being able to cut their Christmas tree from their own farm. In 1993, Tom and Kerry opened the farm to sell trees. The first year they sold 200 trees.

In the fall of 2013, Lucas, Tom and Kerry's son, left a job as an engineer to pursue his passion for agritourism. He and his wife Dana came back to join the farming operation and helped grow the business by adding a fall season consisting of u-pick pumpkins, a corn maze, and many other entertaining activities for people to enjoy. Our fall season, known as Dulls' Pumpkin Harvest, officially started in 2014 and has provided many families and school children with engaging fall fun and education on the farm during the month of October.

We operate the Stone Cabin Inn bed and breakfast in an original log cabin that we moved on to the farm and restored. We also recently moved another pin frame barn to the premises and use it as the Haymow Barn event center. We retired from corn and soybean production in 2018 to focus all our energy on growing the Christmas tree and pumpkin farm. Last year we marketed about 6,000 Christmas trees, planted around 8,900 trees in the Spring of 2021, and welcomed around 30,000 visitors to the Pumpkin Harvest.

Tom, Kerry, Lucas, and Dana now co-own Dull's Tree Farm. Erin, Tom and Kerry's daughter, was hired on two years ago to manage events at the farm. Dull's Tree Farm employee around 120 seasonal staff during our fall and tree season and has begun the process of hiring more full-time staff throughout the year. Our mission is to be the best stewards of the resources God has entrusted to us while providing our visitors with high quality agricultural products in a friendly environment where educational and memorable experiences abound. We look forward to hosting you at our farm this summer!


